Late registrants will be grouped as they register.

Verification of Registration: You must be verified by no later than 7:45 a.m. on both Saturday and Sunday. If you decide not to attend and our pre-registered or decide not to shoot on the second day. PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL AND TELL THE REGISTRATION DESK OR CALL.

Important: Be sure to bring your NFAA or MAA card with current average calculated. This is a MUST.... There must be 5 shoots in the style in which you will be shooting listed on your NFAA card, since September 2010, in order to be classified. Otherwise you must shoot in the highest class. Incomplete does not count as a shoot. Guest shooters are cordially invited. Out-of-state MAA members must have a majority of their shoot scores on their card shot in Maryland or National shoots, and they can compete in only one state shoot in the Mid-Atlantic Region.

Archers will be able to join the MAA and NFAA on Saturday prior to shooting. If you have any questions, please call Colleen McGowan, Tournament Chairman. HM (703) 476-1755, C (703) 606-6785 -GROUPING BY THE REGISTRATION COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL.

Rounds will be shot in accordance with NFAA rules. Class will be determined according to MAA rules. No person (except authorized personnel) will be allowed on the range or within the area of practice butts during the shoot, unless actually participating in the shoot.

The first target which each archer is assigned will be used as a practice target. We will be using the NFAA 5-4-3 face. Shooters will reverse their order of shooting for each 14 target unit.

Teams: All teams will be recognized. Teams must be registered by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 29, 2009. Teams will consist of two archers of the same style and division of shooting from the same home club. Cub or Youths cannot compete on adult teams. Fee \$15.00 per team. Club teams are also recognized. Club teams must be registered by 8.00 a.m. on Saturday.

Alcohol: No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on any of the ranges at any time during the tournament. Any violation of the above will result in disqualification by the tournament committee.

Awards: Both individual and team awards will be presented according to the NFAA Unit Rule and individual awards according to the MAA class system. Individual award pins will be presented at the end of the tournament. Team awards and individual plaques will be presented at the MAA banquet in October.
